Before you start...

Here are a few pointers to keep in mind when writing your podcast script:

1. Keep It Brief

Keeping your script brief gives you the freedom to talk naturally on a podcast rather than relying on a script - it also avoids you slipping over your words!

2. Keep It Conversational

This is your script, write it in your voice and in a way that you will understand when it comes to recording.

3. Don't Be Afraid to go Off-Script

Your script is there to keep you on track, but don't let it restrict you from having interesting conversations!
